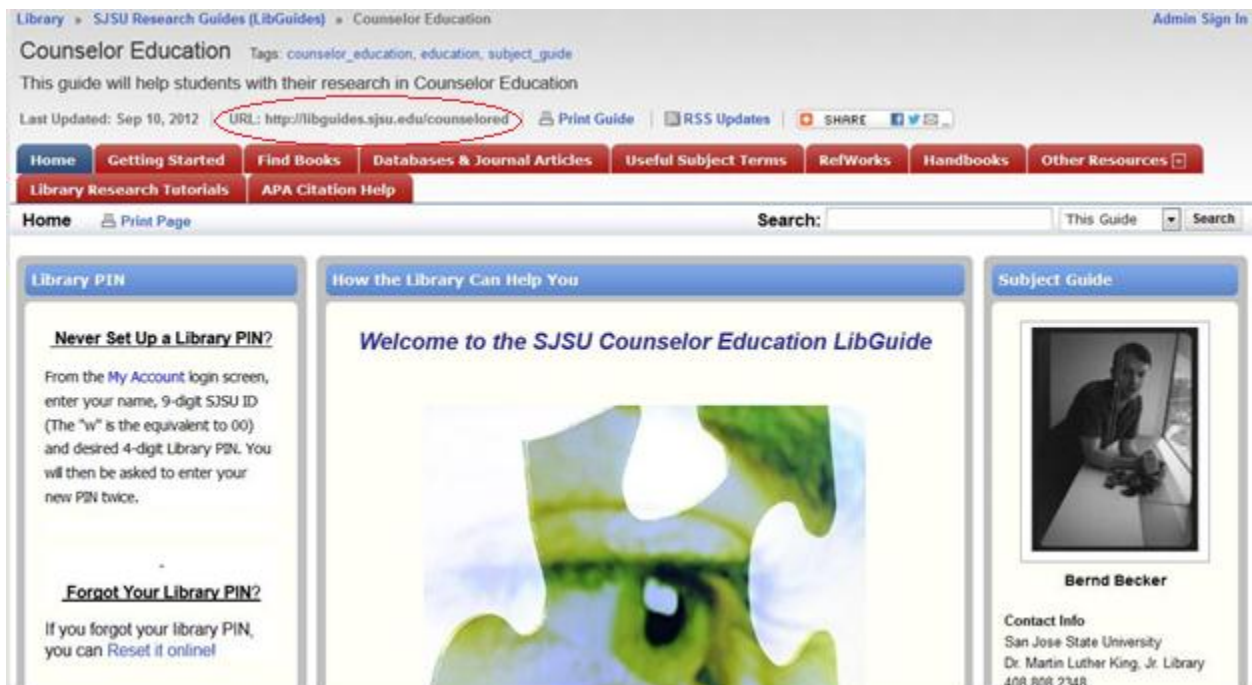


Embedding SJSU Library Research Guides into your Canvas Classroom

SJSU librarians design research guides that help students work through research assignments and connect them to a subject special librarian in the discipline.

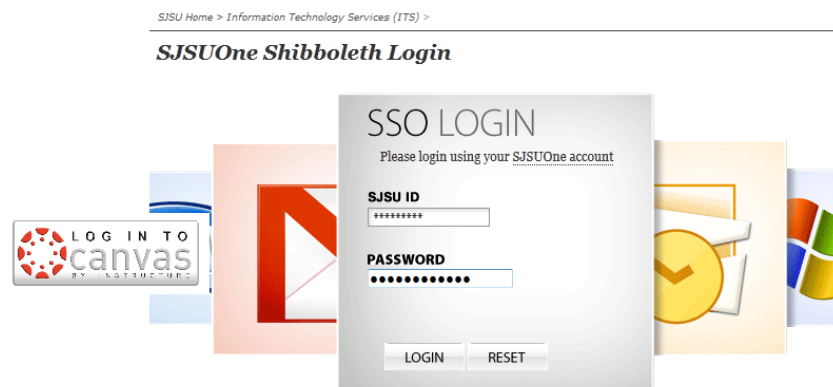
Step 1

Go the library SJSU Research Guides (LibGuides) for your discipline at <http://libguides.sjsu.edu/index>. Copy your discipline URL for later use.



Step 2

Log into your Canvas Classroom: <http://www.sjsu.edu/at/ec/canvas/index.html>



Step 3

Click on **Modules**


Click “**Add item**” to your module

Step 5


Click on the add button and scrolled down to “External URL” click add item.


Step 6

Paste the “Research Guide URL” that you copied into the field, add your “Page Name” and click add item
